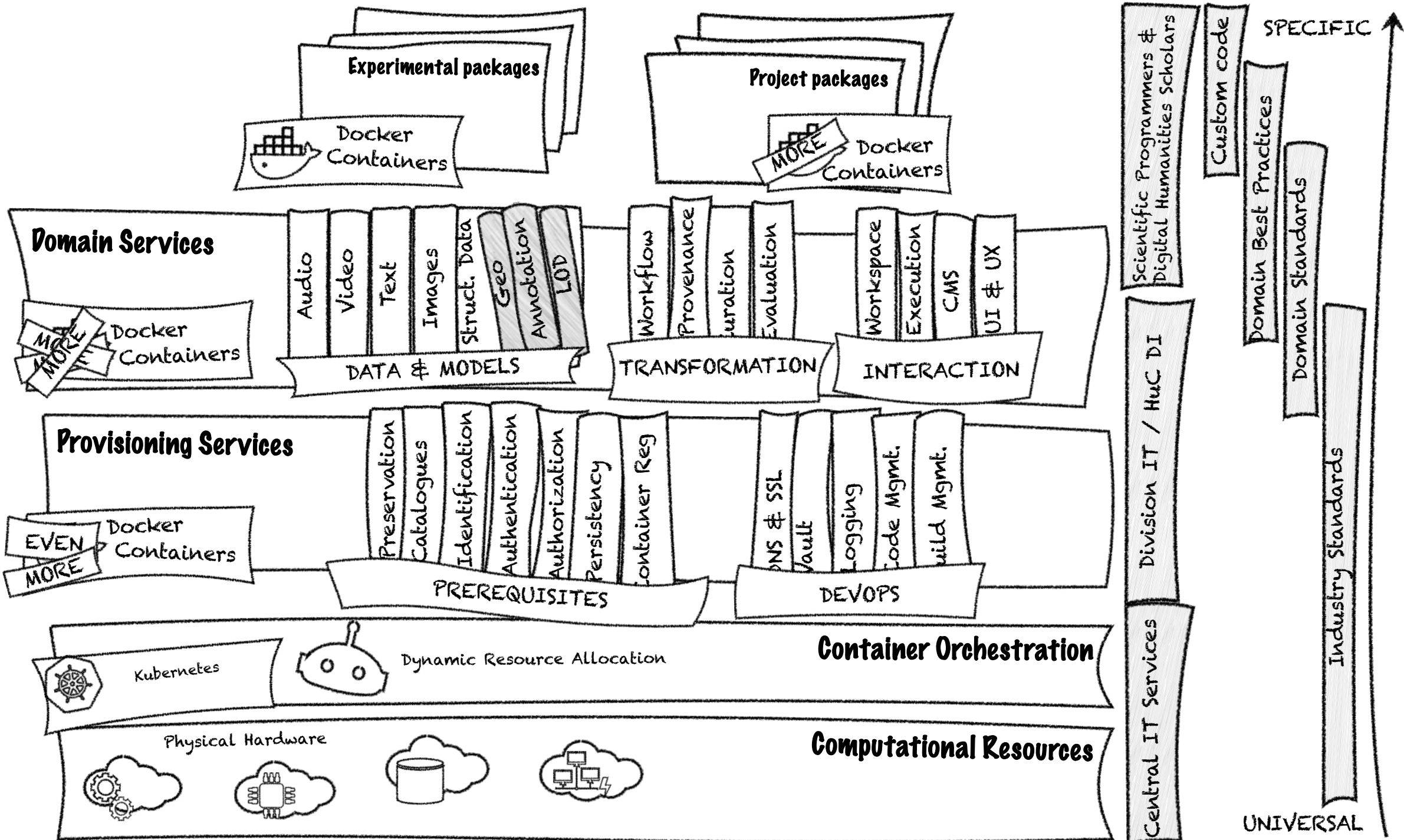

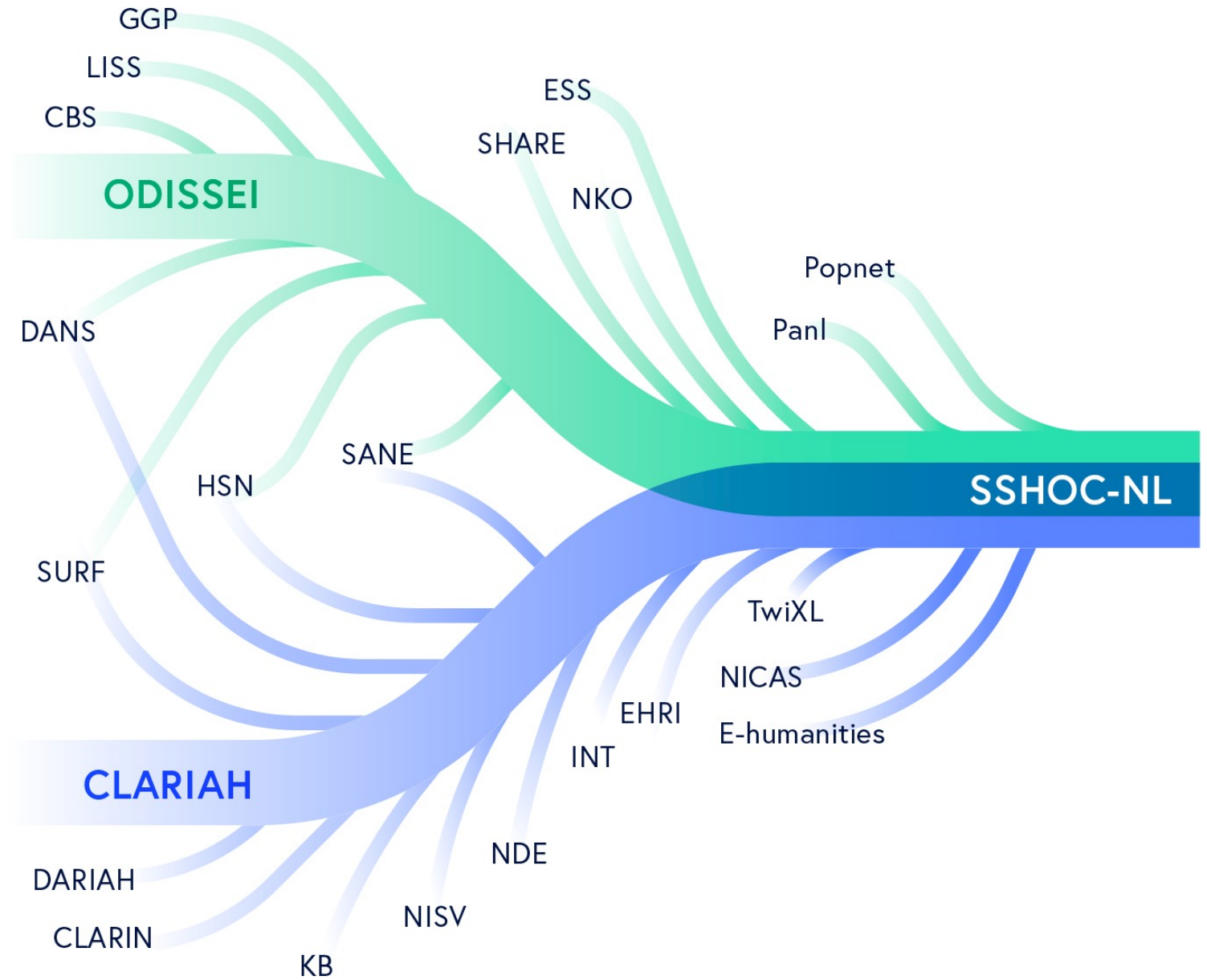

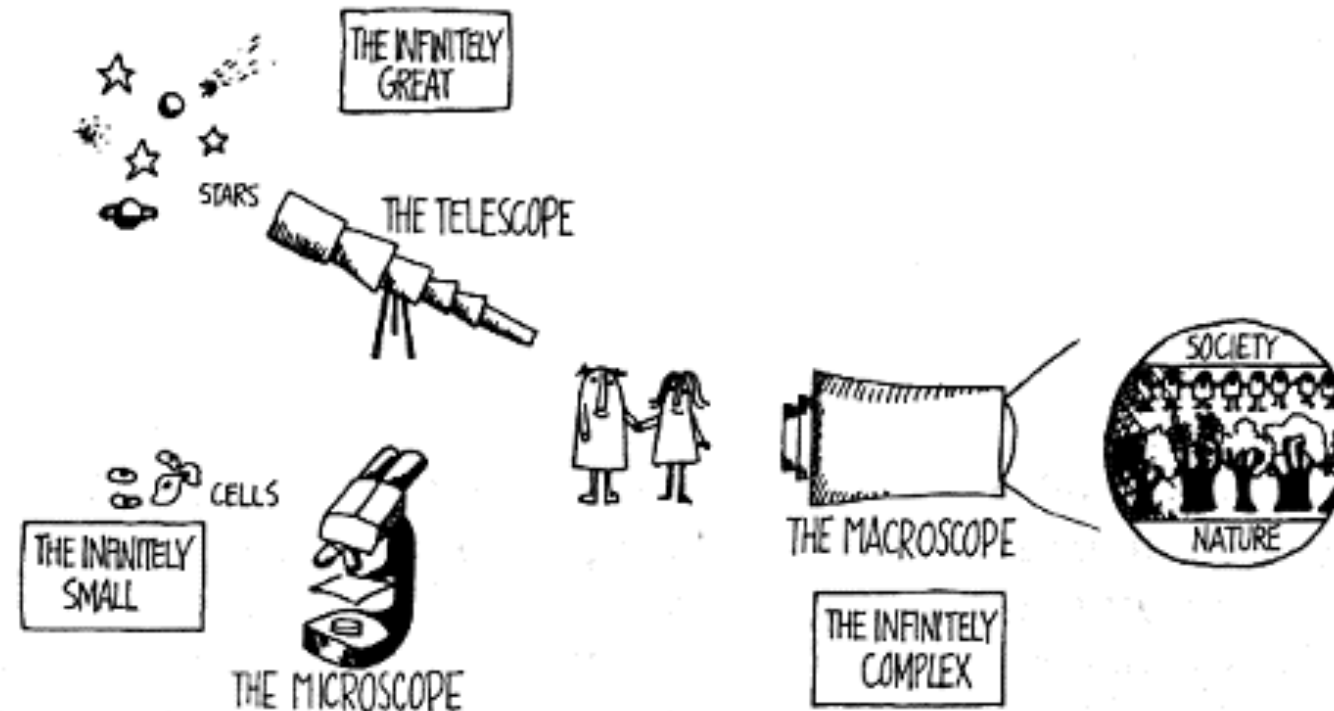

The SSH Macroscopic

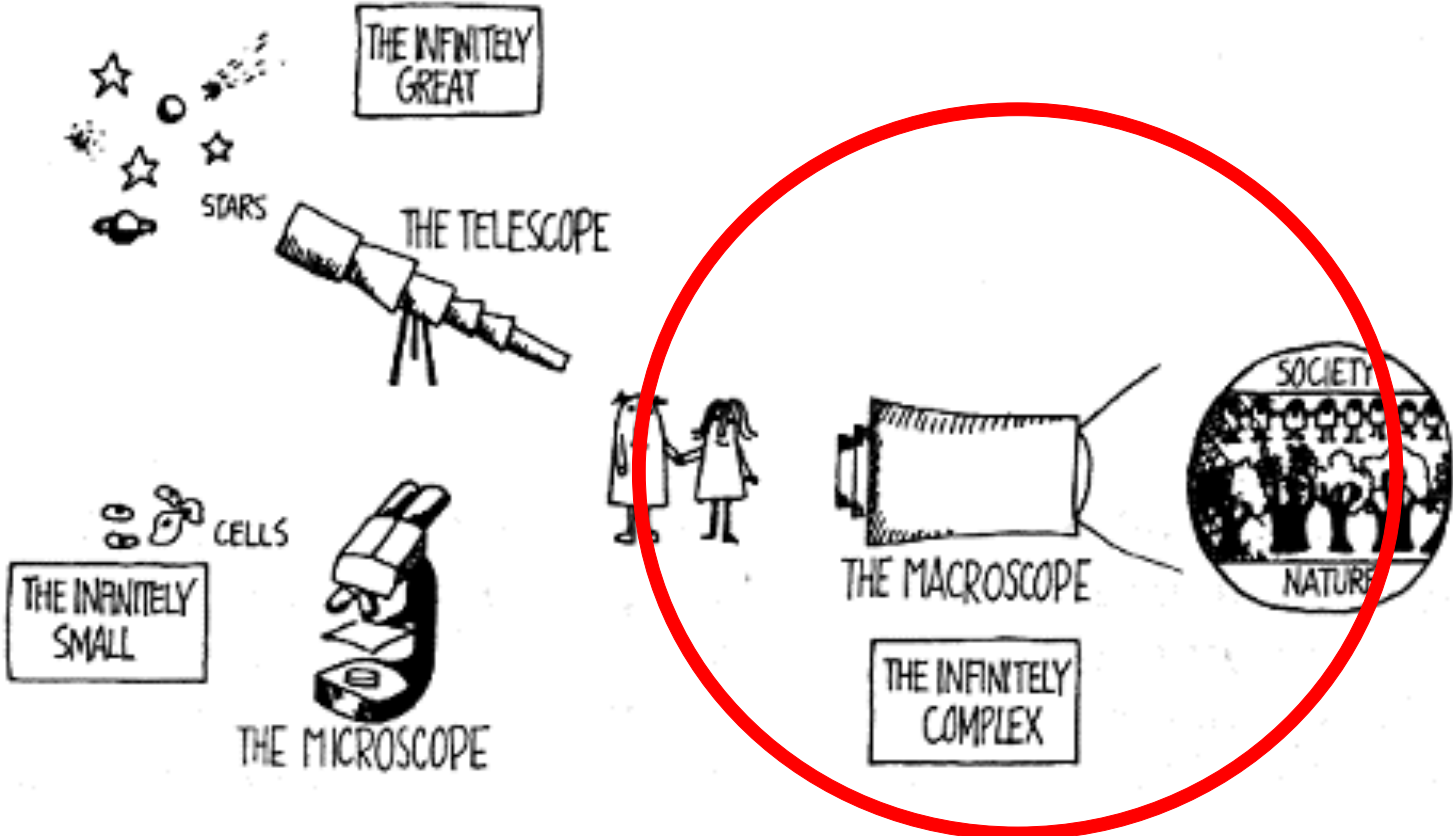
A Unified Social Sciences & Humanities Infrastructure for Studying Change, Crises and Divisions
